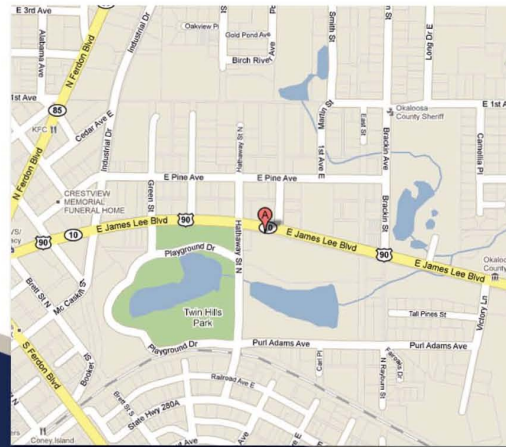

The Okaloosa County Health Department Dental Clinic provides diagnostic, restorative, preventative, and educational services to children.

Our full-service clinic accepts children ages 4-18 who are covered by active Florida Medicaid.

Appointments can be made by calling 850.689.5593. Phone lines open at 7:30 am, Monday thru Friday. No messages please.

Patients are required to keep scheduled appointments unless rescheduled or cancelled at least 24 hours before the appointment time.

available services*

prophylaxis (cleanings)

removal of plaque and calculus from the teeth above & beneath the gumline; includes scaling, polishing, and oral hygiene instruction

x-rays

periapical (of the root), panoramic (upper & lower jaw), and bitewing (back teeth)

sealants

a thin, plastic film painted on the chewing surfaces of permanent back teeth to prevent decay

fluoride varnish treatment

concentrated form of fluoride applied to the smooth surfaces of teeth

pulpotomy

surgical removal of part of the dental pulp (soft part inside the tooth containing blood vessels & nerves)

stainless steel crowns

covers for decayed or damaged teeth, made of metal

unilateral space maintainers

attach to one side of a tooth and hold the space for a permanent tooth (used when a primary tooth is lost due to accident or decay)

sedative restorations (fillings)

fillings that soothe and protect a tooth until it is ready for final restoration

restorations (fillings)

a material is used to restore the function & integrity of a decaying or traumatized tooth

extractions

removal of unrepairable teeth

Please note: Our clinic does not use nitrous oxide or oral sedation.
