

DOES YOUR CHILD QUALIFY FOR **FREE** DENTAL CARE?

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Students ages 4-18 who have a family income that is at or below 200% of the Federal poverty level and have no dental insurance. Students who might qualify include those who receive free/reduced lunch or WIC/food stamp recipients.

WHAT DOES THIS ALL MEAN?

FREE primary dental care will be provided to qualifying students. Primary dental care consists of dental exams including x-rays, teeth cleaning, sealants, fluoride treatments, fillings, space maintainers, extractions, emergency care, stainless steel crowns, and other similar services.

HOW CAN WE ENROLL?
