**H1N1 Vaccine Available for Even More
Vaccine for people 25 through 64 with chronic medical conditions**

OKALOOSA COUNTY – Dr. Karen Chapman, Director of the Okaloosa County Health Department, has announced that the H1N1 vaccine will be available for even more Okaloosa residents beginning Wednesday.

As of November 4, 2009, persons aged **25 through 64 years who have medical conditions that put them at higher risk** for influenza-related complications, **parents/caregivers of children who are less than 6 months old, children/young adults who are aged 6 months through 24 years, and pregnant women** can come to the Health Department locations in Ft Walton Beach and in Crestview for an H1N1 vaccination.

Depending on the county’s supply and demand, the Health Department will have the H1N1 vaccine for other populations as soon as possible. Frequently visit www.HealthyOkaloosa.com to find out who is being vaccinated each day.
