**H1N1 Vaccination Clinics
Extended hours, new dates, and clinic for college students**

OKALOOSA COUNTY – Dr. Karen Chapman, M.D., Director of the Okaloosa County Health Department, will extend the hours of many H1N1 vaccination clinics in order to better accommodate the community. Residents can take advantage of the new schedule and get H1N1 vaccinations at no cost at either of the Health Department locations.

Additional hours have also been added for the week of Thanksgiving. From Nov 23 – 25, vaccinations will be given from 7:30 am – 12 pm and from 12:30 pm – 4:30 pm. An additional clinic has been added on Nov 28 for college students returning to Okaloosa County for the Thanksgiving Holiday. The student clinic will be set up in the Surgery Center at Twin Cities Hospital from 10 am – 12 pm.

As of Nov 16, over 5,030 people have been vaccinated at the Health Department. More than 13,500 doses of the H1N1 vaccine have been distributed to physicians in pediatrics, obstetrics, family medicine, and internal medicine - as well as our local hospitals and military bases.
