**H1N1 Vaccination Clinics
Now available to the general public**

OKALOOSA COUNTY – Dr. Karen Chapman, M.D., Director of the Okaloosa County Health Department, announces the H1N1 vaccine is now available for the general public. Individuals who are 6 months of age and older, regardless of chronic health conditions, place of residence, or history of H1N1 - are encouraged to attend one of the Okaloosa County vaccination clinics to receive the H1N1 vaccine at no charge. Appointments are not necessary.

The Okaloosa County Health Department will offer additional H1N1 Vaccination Clinic dates after December 17. This new schedule will be published soon.

As a reminder, children 6 months through 9 years old who have already received one dose of the H1N1 vaccine will need a second dose no earlier than 21 days after the first dose.
